

## CHAPTER 259.

CHAP. 261.

*An act to divorce August Utermohle, from his wife Fredericke Utermohle.* Passed Mar. 16, 1840.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorcee*  
That August Utermohle, of the city of Baltimore, be and he is hereby divorced from his wife Fredericke Utermohle, a vinculo matrimonii.

## CHAPTER 260.

*An act to authorise Richard C. Hardesty, Collector of the First Collection District of Anne Arundel County, to complete his Collections of County Taxes in said District.* Passed Mar. 16, 1840.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Richard C. Hardesty, collector of the first collection district of Anne Arundel county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect any taxes, or balance of taxes, now remaining due to and uncollected by him in the district aforesaid, in the same manner, and with the same power and privileges, as are allowed by the existing laws in said cases made and provided.* Authorised to make collection

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That this act shall not continue in force longer than one year from the date of the passage thereof.* In force

## CHAPTER 261.

*An act to divorce John Hayes, of the City of Baltimore, from his wife Harriet Hayes.* Passed Mar. 16, 1840.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorcee*  
That John Hayes, of the city of Baltimore, be and he is hereby divorced from his wife Harriet Hayes, a vinculo matrimonii.
