Preamble

Withhams, it is represented to this General Assembly, that it may conduce to the interest of Virginia W. Mason, of Washington county, a minor, of the sgeoof inteten, to sell or exchange the real estate, without improvements, of which she is now seized, to the end that she may thereby be enabled to acquire other lands with improvements; which sale or exchange she is not competent to make in consequence of her legal incapacity to contract—therefore,

Legal incapacity removed

ENCTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the legal incapacity of the said Virgina W. Mason to contract for the sale, or to effect an exchange of the real estate of which she is seized, be and the same is hereby removed.

Sale and deed made valid

real estate made by her, shall be valid and binding, notwithstanding her legal minority; and that any deed executed by her to the pirchaser or purchases thereof, shall be as effectual to pass the title in and thereto, as if she was of full ace.

Empowered to
