

- CHAP. 281.** it shall be to preside at the meetings of the said commissioners and preserve order, and give such directions as may be deemed necessary by the said commissioners, to carry into full effect the provisions of this act.
- His duties**
- May hold meetings** **SEC. 6.** *And be it enacted,* That the commissioners aforesaid, or a majority of them, may meet together, from time to time, as often as occasion may require, upon the business of said Bridgetown, and not less than once in every three months; and if during the year for which they may be elected, any of the commissioners should die, resign, remove from said town, or become non compos mentis, or otherwise disqualified, an election to fill the vacancy shall be held, at which all persons qualified, as is specified in the section of this act, shall be entitled to a vote.
- In case vacancies occur**
- Authorised to appoint a clerk** **SEC. 7.** *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall have power to appoint a clerk and assign his duties, and allow him such compensation for his services, as they may think proper; and that all ordinances passed by the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall by their clerk be entered in a book to be kept by him for that purpose, and shall be open at all times for the inspection of any person interested; and copies of all ordinances shall be put up in the most public places of said town, that the same may be generally made known.
- His duties**
- Fines, &c. how recoverable** **SEC. 8.** *And be it enacted,* That all fines and forfeitures under the ordinances of the said corporation, shall be recoverable as small debts are recoverable before a justice of the peace.
- Limits of town** **SEC. 9.** *And be it enacted,* That the limits of the said Bridgetown, shall commence at the forks of the roads at the east end of said town, and thence running south until it intersects the tan yard branch, thence running with said branch until a due north line will include all the buildings on that part of said town, thence north thirty-five perches, thence easterly so as to include all the houses and lots within the limits of said town, until a due south line will go to the first place of beginning; and the property within said limits shall be subject to such taxes and charges as may be deemed necessary by the said commissioners, or a majority of them, to support and maintain the expenses which may at any time be incurred in the improvement of said town.
