Passed Mar. 17, An act to make valid a Deed from Henry Lamen, and Fra-1840 na his wife, to Jacob Otto.

Deed made va- Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland That the deed of conveyance or instrument of writing, made by Henry Laman, and Frana his wife, to Jacob Otto, dated the thirteenth day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, conveying the following land, being in Allegany county, Maryland, to wit: Addition to Springfield. and part of a tract of land called Springfield, which said deed was recorded on the second day of November, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, in liber A. B. number ten, folio two hundred and forty-seven, two hundred and fortyeight and two hundred and forty-nine, one of the land records of Allegany county, is hereby made good and valid to all intents and purposes, as if the said grantors had been naturalized citizens at the time of its execution; provided however, the same was executed and acknowledged according to the laws of this State.
