Divorce

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That James Ridgely, of the city of Baltimore, be and he is hereby divorced from his wife Eliza G. Ridgely, a vinculo matrimonii.

- Passed Mar. 18, An act for the relief of Sarah Ryan, Letty Cracklin, of 1840.

- Levy sutherised Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,
 That the levy court of Pince George's county, be and
 they are hereby authorised and required to levy annually,
 for the use of Sarah Ryan, an indigent widow with four
 children, the sur of thirty dollars; and for the use of Let-
- ty Cracklin, also an indigent female, the sum of fifteen

 How collected dollars, to be levied, collected and paid over as other county charges, so long as said levy court shall consider it necessarv.
