

Maryland, at its pleasure, to alter, amend or annul this act of incorporation. CHAP. 309.

CHAPTER 309.

An act for the relief of sundry Poor Persons, in the several Counties therein mentioned. Passed Mar. 19, 1840

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Levy authorised
 That the levy court or county commissioners, as the case may be, of Harford county, Prince George's, Cecil, Baltimore, Carroll, Queen Anne's, Calvert, and Somerset counties, be and they are hereby severally authorised, directed and empowered, at their next annual meeting, so long as they shall see cause, at their discretion, except otherwise directed by this act, to levy and assess on the assessable property of said counties for the use of the several persons hereafter mentioned, any sum of money not exceeding the several sums annexed to their respective names, viz: In Harford county, to Patrick Canary, Harford county twenty dollars, payable to L. M. Jarrett; William Dulen, thirty dollars, payable to Stephen I. Magraw; Francis Fareweather, twenty dollars, payable to John Butler; Elisha Mitchell, thirty dollars; Edward Jackson, thirty dollars, payable to John Kean, former sheriff; Michael M'Laughlin, twenty-five dollars, payable to James Pannel; James Barton, thirty dollars, and Mary Charlton, ten dollars in addition to her present pension. In Cecil Cecil county, to Hugh Kirkpatrick, twenty-five dollars; John and Ann Boyd, each twenty-five dollars; Elizabeth Hargan, twenty dollars. In Prince George's county, Mary Prince George's A. Magruder, ten dollars, payable to Walter B. Brooke; Mary and William Kidwell, ten dollars each, payable to George I. Naylor. In Baltimore county, to John Hen- Baltimore derson, thirty dollars. In Carroll county, Richard Loque, Carroll twenty dollars, and they are hereby required to levy the same. In Queen Anne's county, to Annas Everest, fifteen Queen Anne's dollars; James Collier, twenty dollars; William Walker, twenty dollars, (discretionary.) In Calvert county, to Calvert William Smith, thirty dollars; Rachel Shriver, thirty dollars; Priscilla Grover, thirty dollars in addition to what she is at present entitled to by law, (discretionary.) In Somerset Somerset county, to Betsy Cottingham, forty dollars, payable to Morris H. Adams, and they are hereby required to levy the same.
