CHAPTER 318.

An act to authorise the Commissioners of the Town of Havre Passed Mar 20, de-Grace, to sell a School House, and for other purposes.

Be it reacted by the General dissembly of Maryland, Commissioners of that the commissioners of the town of Havre-de-Grace to sell school in Harford county, be and they are hereby authorised to house and lot sell the lot of ground and the school house exceted thereon, on the south east corner of Union and St. Clair streets, and with the proceeds of said sale to purchase another To purchase lot and erect a suitable school house thereon in any part another of said town in which they may deem proper.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the lot of ground so Exempt from to be purchased as aforesaid and the house erected there-tax

on, shall be exempt from all tax of whatsoever description.

CHAPTER 319.

An act for the benefit of Nelly Sanders, of Frederick Passed Mar. 20, County. 1840.

WHEREAS, by a deed executed the fifteenth day of Preamble February, eighteen hundred and thirty-four, by Brook Baker and wife to George Coats and Nelly Sanders, certain lands in Frederick county is conveyed to the said George Coats and Nelly Sanders and their heirs, and the said George Coats being now dead, without heirs and intestate, it is doubtful whether an undivided moiety of the land does not belong to the State.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, State's right to That all right and title which the State has acquired to landransferred said land, by reason of the death of the said George Coats, intestate and without heirs, be and the same is hereby released and transferred to the said Nelly Sanders.
