CHARLES CO. —Voters qualified to vote for members of the House of Delegates, at the annual election of delegates, and at the same time every three years, vote for seven persons, etc.	“	4
Judges of election, etc. to make return in manner similar to return for delegates, etc. returning judges to meet on same day and place, and when met to ascertain and certify number of votes given, etc. and also to certify and return to the clerk of the county, the seven persons having the highest number of votes, as elected commissioners to serve for three years, etc. certificates to be deposited with clerk by said judges and filed; commissioners elected to choose one of their body as president; in case any commissioner should die or neglect to qualify, etc. within sixty days, or remove from the county, etc. a majority to appoint a person, etc. to serve until next election, etc.	“	5
