

Passed Jan. 16, 1840. *A supplement to an act, entitled an act for the reassessment and revaluation of the Real and Personal Property of Allegany county, passed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight.*

Preamble

WHEREAS at the December session of eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, an act, entitled an act for the reassessment and revaluation of the real and personal property of Allegany county was passed: the eleventh section of said act makes it obligatory upon the assessors of said county to make a return of the assessment and valuation of said property to the commissioners of Allegany county, on or before the first day of October, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine; and whereas the assessors failed to make said return according to the eleventh section of said act for want of time;

Return of assessment to be made

SECTION 1. *Be it therefore enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* The return of the assessment and valuation of the real and personal property of Allegany county be made, upon the first Monday of April, eighteen hundred and forty, to the commissioners of Allegany county; and if ratified and confirmed by them, the said commissioners of Allegany county, or a majority of them, at their next or regular stated meeting, after the said return shall have been made, shall be good and valid to all intents and purposes.

If ratified to be valid

Repealed

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the eleventh section of the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, chapter two hundred and fifteen, for the reassessment and revaluation of the real and personal property of Allegany county, is hereby repealed and of no effect.

Compensation allowed person who made out books, &c.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the county commissioners be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to allow such compensation as they may deem reasonable, to the person or persons who made out the books and papers for the use of the assessors appointed under the act to which this is a supplement.
