WHEREAS no act of the General Assembly of this Preamble.
State, passed at its last session, continuing such acts, as
from the limitations thereof did expire with the last ses-

sion—therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Acts revived.

Maryland, That such acts as expired with the session of
the last General Assembly except such parts as shall have
been repealed, be and the same are hereby revived, re-enacted and declared to be in full force until the end of the
next General Assembly, and in the same manner, with the
same legal effect and operation in law, as if such acts had
been continued at the last session of the General Assembly, until the end of the session of the next General Assembly of this State.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all acts and doings To have force under color of such acts so expiring, shall receive the like and effect, &c. construction, and have the like operation and force as if such acts had been continued at the last session of the

General Assembly.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That such acts as would Acts continued expire with the present session of the General Assembly, be and the same are hereby continued to the end of the session of the next General Assembly of this State.
