CHAPTER 90.

An act to appoint the Sheriffs or the Collectors of Public Taxes for Anne Arundel County and Howard District, in said County, the Collectors of Primary Schools District Taxes in said County and Howard District. Passed Mar. 10,
1840

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That, from and after the passage of this act, it shall be incumbent on any sheriff or county collector in Anne Arundel county or Howard District, in the event of being selected or appointed a collector for any or all of the school districts, to accept of the appointment, or forfeit for each refusal, the sum of one hundred dollars, to be recovered on presentment or indictment by a grand jury, and to pay over to the persons or person authorized to receive the same, the several sums of money to be by him collected, (first deducting the usual fees for his services,) within six months from the time the assessment lists shall be placed in his hands for collection; and that the collectors of the school tax shall have the same power of execution, sale and conveyance, to enforce the payment of taxes, as those with which the collector of the county tax is or may be invested.

Sheriff. &c. to accept collectorship
