CHAPTER 136.

Passed Mar. 7, 1838. *A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to authorise the laying out and opening a Road through a part of Anne Arundel and Montgomery counties.*

Change of location

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners named in the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-six, chapter one hundred and twenty-three, be, and they are hereby authorised to make such change or changes in the location of said road as they deem expedient; provided, that, that part of said road in Montgomery county shall be located on the northwest side of the branch known by the name of Garner's Spring Branch, until it reaches a small branch running out of the farm of Colonel Lyde Griffith, then on the nearest and most practicable route, to the old Quaker Road, neary Henry Griffith of Lyde.*

Additional levy directed

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That, for the purpose of laying out and opening said road, the further sum of two hundred and seventy-five dollars is hereby appropriated, on the part of Anne Arundel, and seventy-five dollars on the part of Montgomery counties, to be levied on said counties respectively, and collected as other county charges are now collected.*

CHAPTER 137.

Passed Mar. 7, 1838. *A suplliment to an act, entitled, an act relating to the public roads, in the several counties therein mentioned, passed in eighteen hundred and one, chapter fifty four.*

List of persons in default

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be the duty of overseers, of the public roads in Charles county, to keep a true and proper list, of all and every person or defaulter, who being summoned as provided for in the act to which this is a supplement, shall neglect or refuse to attend at the times and places appointed as aforesaid, or if attending, shall not perform his reasonable labor, and*
