An act to authorise Jane Hutton and Margaret Hutton, Passed Mar. 9, of the City of Baltimore, to hold, inherit and dispose of, real estate, and to be appointed executrixes, administratrixes or guardians.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Authority gran-Maryland, That Jane Hutton and Margaret Hutton of the city of Baltimore, shall be, and they are hereby authorised and enabled to have, hold, take, inherit, possess, enjoy and dispose of by contract, deed, devise by the last will or otherwise, any lands, tenements or hereditaments within this State, which they or either of them have acquired or may hereafter acquire, and any, As if naturaland every interest and estate in such lands, tenements ised and hereditaments, in the same manner and as fully,
