CHAPTER 143.

*An act for the benefit of Frederick Gardner, of Frederick county.* Passed Mar. 9,  
1838.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Levy \$30, for That the levy court of Frederick county be, and they are hereby authorised, in their discretion, annually to levy a sum of money not exceeding thirty dollars, for the use of Frederick Gardner, of Frederick county, in addition to the amount now allowed to him as a pensioner by the county assessment.

CHAPTER 144.

*An act to divorce Samuel Roberts, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Mary Ann Roberts.* Passed Mar. 9,  
1838.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Divorce That Samuel Roberts, of the city of Baltimore, be, and he is hereby divorced from his wife Mary Ann Roberts, *a vinculo matrimonii.*

CHAPTER 145.

*An act to authorise the Commissioners of the Tax for Carroll county, to borrow money for the erection of the public buildings.* Passed Mar. 12,  
1838

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Authority granted That the commissioners of the tax for Carroll county be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to borrow on the credit and faith of the county, on the best terms, a sum of money not exceeding sixteen
