CHAPTER 155.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That so much of the law to which this is a supplement, making it obligatory upon the commissioners therein named, to locate a certain call in the road therein mentioned, east of Samuel Winer's dwelling, be, and the same is hereby repealed; provided, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to prevent the commissioners, or a majority of them, under oath or affirmation, from making such location for this part of the above named road as they may deem best and most practicable and with the least expense to said counties.
