CHAPTER 198.

Passed Mar. 21, An act to authorise the laying out and opening a Road in Worcester county, therein mentioned.

Commissioners to lay out and open

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That John N. Whittington, Francis Mezick, Matthias N. Lindsey, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to survey, lay out and open a road, not exceeding twenty feet in width, in the best and straightest direction, taking all circumstances into consideration, commencing at the corner of Levi Merrill's fence, on the county road leading from New Town to Cedar Hall; thence running across what is called the New Bridge, and through the lands of William Schoolfield, Elijah Schoolfield, Joseph Schoolfield, Samuel Brittingham, Joseph B. Houston and John U. Dennis, to intersect the Pitt's Creek Road, somewhere in the neighborhood of Noah-Carsley's; and the said commisioners shall make out a plat, and

return the same to the clerk of Worcester county
