CHAPTER 208.

A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to Incorporate the Trustees of Prince Frederick Town Academy, in Calvert County. Passed Feb. 28,
1838.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Meeting
That any five or more of the Trustees of Prince Frederick Town Academy, with or without the president, shall be and are hereby empowered to meet at said school from time to time, and they, or a major part of them, so met, may do any act, matter or thing, which said president and trustees might do, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER 209.

A supplement to the act, entitled, an act to authorise John Armstrong, of Baltimore County, to hold real estate, passed at December session eighteen hundred and twenty-eight, chapter forty-eight. Passed Mar. 3,
1838.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, May sell property, &c.
That the said John Armstrong shall be, and he is hereby as fully authorised and enabled to dispose of by gift, sale, devise, or in any other lawful manner, as he is to hold, possess and enjoy lands, tenements and hereditaments within this State, and any estate, interest, right and claim therein; and that every contract and conveyance made to, with or by the said John Armstrong in regard to the same, shall by virtue of the said original act and this supplement, have, and be
