CHAPTER 262.

*An act authorising John E. Taylor, to bring into this State, a negro boy named Lewis.* Passed Mar. 22,  
1838.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Leave granted  
to import  
That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be lawful for John E. Taylor, of Baltimore county, to bring into this State, a negro boy named Lewis, a slave for life, by complying with the requisitions of the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter eighty seven.

CHAPTER 263.

*An act entitled a supplement to the act, entitled an act to Incorporate the Union Bank of Allegany.* Passed Mar. 22,  
1838.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Nine directors  
That the affairs of the Union Bank of Allegany, shall be conducted by nine directors, of whom, seven shall be residents of Allegany county, instead of thirteen, as directed by the act to which this is a supplement, and the directors and president first chosen, shall serve until the first Monday in May next succeeding the organization of said company, and be succeeded by a like number, to be chosen annually thereafter agreeably to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement; *provided*, that no director shall serve as such longer than two years successively in any three years, that a majority of said directors shall constitute a sufficient number for the transaction of business, any thing in the act to which this is a supplement, to the contrary notwithstanding; *and provided also*, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to prevent the continuous election and service of the president.
