CHAPTER 330.

Passed Mar. 29 1838. *An act giving discretionary power to the Levy Court of Frederick County, to authorise repairs to the Court House.*

Authority granted *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,*
That the levy court of Frederick county be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered to make such alterations and repairs to the court-house in Frederick county, as they may deem proper, out of the materials of the old clerk's office, and such other materials as may be necessary, in such manner as to suit the public convenience. and to preserve the public records and papers of the county; *provided,* the sum levied for this purpose, shall not exceed two thousand dollars, and the amount levied in any one year shall not exceed one thousand dollars.

CHAPTER 331.

Passed Mar. 29 1838. *An act to alter and change the lines of the Ninth Election District of Carroll County.*

Lines changed *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,*
That from and after the passage of this act, the lines and boundaries of the ninth election district of Carroll county shall be as follows, to wit: beginning at Parr's Spring, and running with the original lines to Morgan's Run; thence with Morgan's Run to Richard Frizzle's Branch; thence with said branch to a road leading from Philip Nicodemus' Mill to the Calico House; thence with the said road to Philip Nicodemus' Mill; thence with the original lines to the place of beginning.

Voting **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That all persons who may be included within the limits of the proposed new lines, shall be entitled to vote at the polls of the district into which they may fall, at all new elections.
