CHAPTER 43.

Passed Feb. 8, 1838. *A supplement to an act entitled, an act, to establish State Warehouses in the City of Baltimore, for the Inspection of Tobacco, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-three, chapter one hundred and sixty-five, and the several supplements thereto.*

Inspector appointed **SECTION. 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and Council be authorized, and are hereby required, to appoint an additional Inspector for the new State Tobacco Warehouse in Baltimore, the said Warehouse to be known as number four.*

His powers and duties **SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted, That the time of appointments, duties, and powers of said Inspector, shall in all respects be the same as are authorized and required by the said original act, and its several supplements.*

Salary \$1,200 **SEC. 3.** *And be it enacted, That the salaries of the State Tobacco Inspectors, shall be twelve hundred dollars per annum, each.*

Account and annual report from Inspectors required **SEC. 4.** *And be it enacted, That the Inspectors of the several State Tobacco Warehouses aforesaid, shall keep a separate list for each county, of the number of Hogsheads of Tobacco, brought into and inspected by them in their respective warehouses, and report the same to the General Assembly of Maryland, annually.*
