An act to divorce John McMillan, of the City of Baltimore, from his wife, Mary Ann McMillan.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Divorce
That John McMillan, of the City of Baltimore, be, and he is hereby declared to be divorced from his wife, Mary Ann McMillan, *avinculo matrimonii*.
