CHAPTER 7.

An act to authorize John Milburn to bring into this State, a negro slave for life. Passed Jan. 15,
1838.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Permission
granted
That from and after the passage of this act, it shall, and may be lawful for John Milburn to bring into this State, a negro man named Nace, a slave for life, the property of the said John Milburn; *provided*, that within thirty days after such removal, the said John Milburn shall cause to be recorded in the office of the clerk of Saint Mary's County Court, the name and sex of the said negro slave so removed.

CHAPTER 8.

An act to compensate Robert B. A. Tate, for extra services as clerk of the Levy court, of Queen Anne's county. Passed Jan. 20,
1838.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Compensation
directed
That the Treasurer, of the Levy court of Queen Anne's county, pay to Robert B. A. Tate, the sum of one hundred dollars, for extra services rendered by him as clerk of said court, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty seven.

CHAPTER 9.
