

tion year for which issued. The registration of all other classes of motor vehicles and the registration cards and plates for the same issued hereunder shall expire at midnight on the thirtieth day of April of the registration year for which issued.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly of Maryland, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 12

(House Bill 13)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section 34(b) of Article 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition—being Sub-section 30(b) in the 1947 Supplement), title “Motor Vehicles,” Sub-title “Administration—Registration—Titling,” specifying the time during which new registration plates may be displayed on motor vehicles prior to the expiration of the previous registration period.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sub-section 34(b) of Article 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition—being Sub-section 30(b) in the 1947 Supplement), title “Motor Vehicles,” sub-title “Administration—Registration—Titling,” be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(b). The Department may receive applications for renewal of registration and grant the same and issue new
