so purchased, or execute notes or make such other agreements and do such other things as may be necessary to obtain the benefits of the said Servicemen's Readjustment Act, and amendments thereto, AND ALSO MAY EXECUTE RELEASES OF CLAIMS in the same manner and with the same effect as though twenty-one years of age. The minor husband or wife of any said war veteran or member of the Armed Services may join in any such deed or mortgage for the purpose of releasing rights of dower and other rights in the same manner and with the same effect as though twenty-one years of age.

S=3. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1952.

SEC. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY LAW AND NECESSARY FOR THE IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, AND HAVING BEEN PASSED BY A YEA AND NAY VOTE, SUPPORTED BY THREE-FIFTHS OF ALL THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH OF THE TWO HOUSES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE SAME SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF ITS PASSAGE.
