

CHAPTER 62

(House Bill 96)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 5(c) of Article 88B of the Annotated Code of Maryland 1951 Edition—being also Section 5(c) in the 1947 Supplement, as amended, title “State Police”, increasing the salaries of the police employees of the Department of Maryland State Police. PLEMENT, AS AMENDED), AND SECTION 23 OF SAID ARTICLE (BEING SECTION 24 IN THE 1947 SUPPLEMENT), TITLE “STATE POLICE”, INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE POLICE EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MARYLAND STATE POLICE AND PROHIBITING THE USE OF THE POLICE EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT FOR FEDERAL DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES OR COMMITTEES ESPECIALLY UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 5(c) of Article 88B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition, being also Section 5(c) in the 1947 Supplement, as amended), title “State Police”, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(c) Salaries to be paid to police employees of the Department shall be as follows:
