Any police employee receiving the salary hereinbefore specified for the rank which he holds when this Act becomes effective shall not have such salary reduced by reason of the establishment of the salary schedule herein prescribed for said rank, so long as he shall remain incumbent in that rank; provided, however, that the holder of the title of Senior Captain shall receive the annual salary of **[\$3,600]** ~~\$2,900.~~ \$3,800.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT SECTION 23 OF ARTICLE 88B OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1951 EDITION—BEING SECTION 24 IN THE 1947 SUPPLEMENT), TITLE "STATE POLICE", BE AND IT IS HEREBY REPEALED AND RE-ENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS, TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

23 (A) THE POLICE EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ACT WITHIN THE LIMITS OF ANY INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY WHICH MAINTAINS A POLICE FORCE EXCEPT (1) WHEN IN PURSUIT OF AN OFFENDER OR SUSPECTED OFFENDER; OR (2) WHEN IN SEARCH OF AN OFFENDER OR SUSPECTED OFFENDER WANTED FOR A CRIME COMMITTED OUTSIDE OF THE LIMITS OF THE MUNICIPALITY, OR WHEN INTERVIEWING OR SEEKING TO INTERVIEW A WITNESS OR SUPPOSED WITNESS TO SUCH A CRIME; OR (3) WHEN REQUESTED TO ACT BY THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE MUNICIPALITY IN QUESTION OR ITS CHIEF POLICE OFFICER, AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 22; OR (4) WHEN ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR, TO ACT WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY IN QUESTION; OR (5) WHEN ENFORCING THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS OF THIS STATE.

(B) NO POLICE EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE PLACED ON DETACHED SERVICE AND ACT FOR ANY FEDERAL DEPARTMENT, AGENCY OR COMMITTEE OUTSIDE OF THE STATE
