SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 348

(Senate Bill 451)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection (b) of Section 11 of Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Fees of Officers", sub-title "Bailiffs", increasing the compensation of the Criers in Queen Anne's County.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (b) of Section 11 of Article 36 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Fees of Officers", sub-title "Bailiffs", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:

11.

- (b) Every court crier attending the Circuit Courts in the counties in this State shall be entitled to the compensation hereinafter prescribed for each day he shall attend said court, except as otherwise herein provided.
- (1) Criers in Charles County shall each receive Four Dollars (\$4.00) per day.
- (2) Criers in Allegany, Caroline, Dorchester, Howard, Kent, Prince George's, Washington and Worcester Counties shall each receive Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day.
- (3) Criers in Anne Arundel County shall each receive Seventy-five (\$75.00) per month.
- (4) Criers in Baltimore and Frederick Counties shall each receive such compensation as the court of said counties shall determine.
- (5) Criers in Calvert County shall each receive One Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) per year.
