CHAPTER 366

(House Bill 187)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section 37B (f) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", authorizing the Sheriff of Carroll County to appoint such deputies as may be necessary for the proper execution of the duties of his office.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sub-section 37B (f) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

37B.

(f) The Sheriff of Carroll County shall receive an annual salary of \$3,000 and \$2,100 to cover all the expenses of his office. He may appoint ~~[a chief deputy sheriff]~~ *such deputies as may be necessary for the proper execution of the duties of his office*, who shall receive such compensation as may be determined by the County Commissioners of said County.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.
