Clerk and approved by the Judges of the Circuit Court for said county, provided the total expenditure for this purpose shall not exceed $\llbracket \$1,000.00 \rrbracket \$2,000.00$ in any single year.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 366

(House Bill 187)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section 37B (f) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", authorizing the Sheriff of Carroll County to appoint such deputies as may be necessary for the proper execution of the duties of his office.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section 37B (f) of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

37B.

- (f) The Sheriff of Carroll County shall receive an annual salary of \$3,000 and \$2,100 to cover all the expenses of his office. He may appoint a chief deputy sheriff such deputies as may be necessary for the proper execution of the duties of his office, who shall receive such compensation as may be determined by the County Commissioners of said County.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.
