canned tomato juice to which has been added tomato juice or juices only from other sound tomatoes, or the selling or offering for sale by wholesale of canned tomatoes of canned tomato juice. To which has been added tomato juice or juices only from other sound tomatoes, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for the first offense and not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for each succeeding offense.

238. Any person, firm or corporation, or the agent of any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this subtitle relative to the sale or the offering for sale at retail of canned tomatoes or canned tomato juice or goods purporting to be canned tomatoes or canned tomato juice [to which has been added tomato juice or juices only from other sound tomatoes], shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) for each and every offense.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

## CHAPTER 371

## (House Bill 228)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 8C, 8D, 8E, 8HA and 8J of Article 78A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Public Works", sub-title "Department of Public Improvements", Section 8E having been amended by Chapter 80 of the Acts of 1949 and Section 8HA having been enacted by said Chapter, changing the title of Chief Engineer and Deputy Chief Engineer to Director of Public Improvements and Deputy Director and providing that the compensation of said Director shall be as provided in the budget.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 8C, 8D, 8E, 8HA and 8J of Article 78A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title
