CHAPTER 52

(Senate Bill 80)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 1-24, inclusive, of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Alms-house," said sections relating to the Trustees of the Poor and the Almshouse in Queen Anne's County.

WHEREAS, the County Almshouse and Farm has been sold, thereby making these sections unnecessary; now therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 1-24, inclusive, of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Alms-house," be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.
