of the use of the entire member, as the affected or amputated portion thereof bears to the whole.

- (f) Disfigurements—For other mutilations and disfigurements not hereinbefore provided for, compensation shall be allowed in the discretion of the Commission, for not more than one hundred weeks, as the Commission may fix, in each case having due regard to the character of the mutilation and disfigurement as compared with mutilation and injury hereinbefore specifically provided for.
- In all other cases of disability, (4) (a) Other Cases. other than those specifically enumerated disabilities set forth in Sub-section (3) of Section 35, which disability is partial in character, but permanent in quality, the Commission shall determine the portion or percentage by which the industrial use of the employee's body was impaired as a result of the injury, and in determining such portion or percentage of impairment resulting in an industrial loss the Commission shall take into consideration, among other things, the nature of the physical injury, the occupation, experience, training and age of the injured employee at the time of injury, and shall award compensation in such proportion as the determined loss bears to Feompensation allowable for permanent total disability, seventy five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) the said compensation to be paid PORTION AS THE DETERMINED LOSS BEARS TO COMPENSATION ALLOWABLE FOR PERMANENT TOTAL DISABILITY, THE SAID COMPENSATION TO BE PAID weekly at the rate of sixty-six and two-thirds per centum of the average weekly wages, in no case to exceed twenty-five dollars per week, and not less than a minimum of Ttwelve I fifteen dollars per week unless the employee's established weekly wages are less than [twelve] fifteen dollars per week at the time of the injury, in which event he shall receive compensation equal to his full wages, but not to exceed [\$5,000] \$7,500 and subject to reconsidera-TO EXCEED \$5,000 \$7,500 AND SUBJECT TO RECON-SIDERA- tion of the degree of such impairment by the Commission on its own motion or upon application of any party in interest.
- (b) The compensation for the foregoing specific injuries, payable under sub-sections (3) and (4), shall be paid in addition to, and consecutively with, the compensation hereinbefore provided in Sub-section 2 of this section.
- (c) If any employee dies from any cause or causes not compensable under this Article, the right to any compensation payable under Sub-sections (3), (4) and (5), un-
