

CHAPTER 455

(Senate Bill 169)

AN ACT to repeal Section 533 of the Charter and Public Local Laws of Baltimore City (1949 Edition), title "Miscellaneous Local Laws", sub-title "Police Commissioner", heading "Organization of Force", and to enact in lieu thereof a new Section, to be known as Section 533, to follow immediately after Section 532, relating to the salaries and compensation of all uniformed officers and all clerical and civilian employees of the Police Department of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. *Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 533 of the Charter and Public Local Laws of Baltimore City (1949 Edition), title "Miscellaneous Local Laws", sub-title "Police Commissioner", heading "Organization of Force", be and the same is hereby repealed, and that a new Section be and it is hereby enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as Section 533, to follow immediately after Section 532, and to read as follows:

533. (1) On and after January 1, 1952, the compensation of all the uniformed officers and all clerical and civilian employees of the Police Department of Baltimore City shall be as provided for in the annual Ordinance of Estimates of Baltimore City.

(2) The Police Commissioner shall, from time to time, designate positions in the Department, which require technical skill for the proper performance of the duties, as technical positions. The Commissioner shall provide for additional compensation for each rank of uniformed officers which shall be paid to those officers who serve in technical positions, designated by the Commissioner as aforesaid, during the time that they serve therein. The Commissioner may, in his discretion, transfer uniformed officers from their technical positions to other positions and they shall thereafter be paid the regular pay for their rank. The Commissioner shall, in his annual estimate prepared in accordance with Section 548 of this Article, make provision for the additional compensation referred to above.

(3) The compensation and salaries of all uniformed officers and all clerical and civilian employees of the Police
