CHAPTER 501

(House Bill 550)

AN ACT to add a new section to the Code of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel County (1947 Edition), being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Anne Arundel County", said new section to be known as Section 400A, to follow immediately after Section 400 thereof and to be under the sub-title "Pensions", giving the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County power to pay a pension to certain former employees over seventy years of age.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel County (1947 Edition), being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Anne Arundel County", said new section to be known as Section 400A, to follow immediatey after Section 400 thereof and to be under the sub-title "Pensions", and to read as follows:

400A. In addition to the powers contained in Section 400 hereinabove, the County Commissioners are authorized to pay a pension of not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month to any former employee of Anne Arundel County who is seventy years of age or more and who for twenty FIFTEEN years or more has been or was employed by the County.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.
