

said Treasurer, the said [Board of County Commissioners] *County Council* shall also order and have paid over to said Treasurer the proportion of the county road tax to be levied and collected in the same manner as is done with other incorporated towns and villages; and said proportion of the county road tax received by the Treasurer of Chevy Chase shall be used by said Board of Managers exclusively for opening, maintaining and repairing the county roads, streets and lanes that may have been dedicated to the public or to Montgomery County and whether accepted by said county or not; all other funds to be used by said Board of Managers directly or through said Board of Managers exclusively for opening, maintaining, repairing and lighting the streets, roads, alleys, sidewalks, parking, drainage, sewerage, sanitation and other village maintenance and improvements, clerical and other public service, for furnishing police protection and public service, including the removal of ashes, garbage, and other refuse, and disposal thereof; for the employment of a building inspector to enforce the requirements of all deeds of conveyance for properties situated in said village for enforcing such building, sanitary and other regulations as said Board of Managers subject to the approval of the [Board of County Commissioners] *County Council* may prescribe for said village, or for any part or section thereof.

88. The [Board of County Commissioners of] *County Council* for Montgomery County [are] is authorized, empowered and directed to levy and cause to be collected from the property owners at the time of the County Tax Levy for the year 1916 and each succeeding year within said described area of Chevy Chase as named or created by this sub-title, amounts to be fixed by them not less than ten (10) cents nor more than fifty (50) cents on each one hundred (100) dollars worth of the assessable property in said part of the Village of Chevy Chase, Montgomery County, to be collected, as all other county taxes in said County are collected; to be paid over by the said [Board of County Commissioners] *County Council* to the Treasurer of said Section 3 of Chevy Chase to be selected from among their number by a majority of the members of the Chevy Chase Citizens' Committee, of said Section 3 herein named, or by their successors to be selected as herein provided. Upon said Treasurer having been duly selected by such Committee and giving [bond to said Board of County Commissioners, to be approved by the Judge of the Circuit Court for Montgomery County in a penal sum to be fixed by said Judge,] *corporate bond to Montgomery County, Maryland, satisfactory to and approved by the County Manager and the County Attorney in a penal sum to be*
