BEING A STRIP OF LAND 200 FEET WIDE ON THE EASTERLY SIDE OF MONTGOMERY ROAD AND 200 FEET WIDE ON SAID WESTERLY SIDE OF SAID MONTGOMERY ROAD FROM POWDER MILL ROAD TO INTERSECT THE WATER MAIN OF THE SAID WASHINGTONSUBURBAN SANITARY COMMISSION, AND RUNNING ALONG BOTH SIDES OF SAID ROAD A DISTANCE OF 2.8 MILES, MORE OR LESS.
