

SEC. 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT BEFORE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE, THE QUESTION SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF CUMBERLAND AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD THEREIN DURING THE YEAR 1952. SAID QUESTION SHALL BE SUBMITTED IN THE MANNER AND AT THE PLACES FOR HOLDING ELECTIONS IN SAID CITY AS PROVIDED FOR SUCH ELECTIONS. THE BALLOTS OF THE VOTING MACHINES AS THE CASE MAY BE SHALL HAVE PRINTED ON THEM A CONDENSED SUMMARY OF THIS ACT, PRINTED ON THE SAID BALLOTS OR VOTING MACHINES AS THE CASE MAY BE SHALL BE THE WORDS "FOR PARKING GARAGE" AND "AGAINST PARKING GARAGE" WITH SUITABLE PROVISION TO BE MADE FOR EACH VOTER TO INDICATE HIS CHOICE ON SAID QUESTION. IF A MAJORITY OF THE PERSONS VOTING ON SAID QUESTION SHALL VOTE "FOR PARKING GARAGE", THEN THIS ACT SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY OF FULL FORCE AND EFFECT. IF A MAJORITY OF THE PERSONS VOTING ON SAID QUESTION SHALL VOTE "AGAINST PARKING GARAGE" THEN THIS ACT SHALL BE VOID AND OF NO FURTHER EFFECT.

SEC. 8. 9. 8. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 581

(House Bill 528)

AN ACT to add a new sub-section to Section 85 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title 'Elections', sub-title "Elections", said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (a-1) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (a) of said Section 85, providing that
