#### BAIL

*28. Whenever any person charged with a criminal offense desires to be admitted to bail, any person having power to admit to bail under any provision in this Article may accept the accused as his own recognizor, upon cash or other property owned by him and upon his conforming otherwise to requirements relating to recognizances as provided by law.*

**SEC. 2.** *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.*

#### CHAPTER 588

(House Bill 670)
