

THORITY, DISCRETION AND OTHER RIGHTS CONFERRED BY THIS ARTICLE UPON THE STATE APPEAL BOARD IN THE PLACE AND STEAD OF SAID STATE APPEAL BOARD; AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT SUCH HOTEL OR RESTURANT SHALL PURCHASE ALL LIQUORS SOLD BY THEM FROM WICOMICO COUNTY LIQUOR DISPENSARY AND SHALL BE CHARGED THEREFOR THE INVOICE PRICE THEREOF TO THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD FOR WICOMICO COUNTY PLUS FREIGHT CHARGES THEREON AND PLUS TWENTY PER CENT (20%) OF SUCH AGGREGATE INVOICE PRICE AND FREIGHT CHARGES FROM TIME TO TIME.

(1) (Wicomico County.) In Wicomico County bona fide hotels having thirty or more rooms and regularly serving meals, and bona fide restaurants owned and operated by registered voters and taxpayers of Wicomico County for more than two years prior to application for the license hereinafter provided for and regularly serving meals and having bona fide table seating capacity and facilities for not less than seventy-five (75) persons, upon payment of an annual license fee of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), may obtain a license from the County Commissioners of Wicomico County and by such license shall be entitled to sell beers, wines and liquors for on the premises consumption between the hours of 10:00 o'clock A. M. and 12:00 o'clock midnight, except that no sales as provided herein shall be made between 12:00 o'clock midnight on nay Saturday and 10:00 o'clock A. M. on the Monday following, and that no such sales shall be made at bars or counters; provided that if any such hotel or restaurant shall be situate within the corporate limits of the City of Salisbury, said County Commissioners shall pay said license fee to the Mayor and Council of Salisbury, otherwise they shall pay the same to the Treasurer of Wicomico County; and provided further that in the issuance, renewal, suspension or revocation of any such license said County Commissioners of Wicomico County shall exercise all the powers, authority, discretion and other rights conferred by this Article upon the State Appeal Board in the place and stead of said State Appeal Board; and provided further that such hotel or restaurant shall purchase all liquors sold by them from Wicomico County Liquor Dispensary and shall be charged therefor the wholesale price thereof to the Liquor Control Board for Wicomico County plus freight charges thereon and plus ten percent (10%) of such aggregate wholesale price and freight charges from time to time, and that one-
