SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 590

(House Bill 682)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Local Licenses and License Provisions", said new section to be known as Section 28A and to follow immediately after Section 28 of said Article, providing for a license to sell alcoholic beverages at race tracks in Howard County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Local Licenses and License Provisions", said new section to be known as Section 28A, to follow immediately after Section 28 of said Article, and to read as follows:

28A. *Race Track License. (1) In Howard County the owner or owners of any regularly licensed racing establishment, whether individual, association of individuals, or a corporation, shall be entitled to procure a license for the sale of any and all alcoholic beverages within the confines of its racing park in said county.*

*(2) The cost for such license shall be ~~\$1,000.00~~ \$750.00 each calendar year, payable to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County, and shall entitle the holder to sell at one or more locations within its said park.*

*(3) Such licenses and the licensees thereunder shall be subject to all laws, rules and regulations applicable in Howard*
