

SEC. 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JUNE 1, 1951. IT IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE THE LEGISLATIVE INTENT THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL APPLY, WITH RESPECT TO TAXPAYERS REPORTING ON A CALENDAR YEAR BASIS, FOR ALL YEARS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1951, OR THEREAFTER, AND THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL APPLY, WITH RESPECT TO TAXPAYERS REPORTING ON A FISCAL YEAR BASIS FOR ALL FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING AFTER JANUARY 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 598

(Senate Bill 138)

AN ACT to repeal Section 23 of Article 64A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Ed.), title "Merit System," repealing obsolete provisions relating to classification of positions made by the Employment Commissioner.

SECTION 1. *Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 23 of Article 64A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Ed.), title "Merit System", be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 599

(Senate Bill 142)
