or benefit. At such carnival, bazaar or raffle it shall be lawful to award prizes in cash or in merchandise by such devices as are commonly designated as paddle wheels, wheels of fortune, chance books, bingo, or any other gaming device, provided however that such carnivals, bazaars or raffles shall be managed by the members of such group, organization or corporation personally through its members.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 604

(Senate Bill 209)

AN ACT to repeal Section 130 and Sub-section 136 (c) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947) Supplement), title "Alcohlic Beverages," sub-title "Boards of License Commissioners"; to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Sub-section 37 (d) of said Article 2B, sub-title "General Provisions on Issue of Licenses"; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments. Sub-sections 127 (e) and 135 (b) of said Article 2B, subtitle "Boards of License Commissioners"; and to add a new sub-section to Section 127 of said Article 2B, subtitle "Boards of License Commissioners", said new subsection to be known as Sub-section (a-1) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (a) thereof, reconstituting the Liquor Control Board of Allegany County as the Board of License Commissioners thereof and relating generally to the members, tenure, salaries and duties of the said Board and to the administration of the business of the said Board.
