salaries and also for the salaries of a Secretary and any other employees and for all other expenses of the Board. The Clerk of the Court shall remit to the account of the Board each month one twelfth of the total amount of such budget for that year, deducting said sums from the license fees collected by him under the provisions of this Article. All such remittances shall be turned over to the County Treasurer, who is authorized and directed upon the order of the Board to disburse the same according to the terms of the said budget.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 605

(Senate Bill 249)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 6 of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Public Education," sub-title "Chapter 2. Formation of Boards," as said section was amended by Chapter 526 of the Acts of 1949; to add a new section to said Article and sub-title, said new section to be known as Section 7C and to follow immediately after Section 7B thereof, as said Section 7B was enacted by Chapter 526 of the Acts of 1949; and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 39 of said Article 77 (1947 Supplement), sub-title "Chapter 4. County Board of Education," relating to the appointment, tenure, traveling and other expenses of the Board of Education of Allegany County.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 6 of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Public Education," subtitle "Chapter 2. Formation of Boards," as said section was amended by Chapter 526 of the Acts of 1949, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments;
