inabove shall continue to apply to the Board of Education of Allegany County.

39. The County Board of Education shall hold an annual meeting each year on the second Tuesday in May, or as near as possible thereto in May. At this meeting the board shall elect one of its members to serve as president and one to serve as vice-president. Other regular meetings shall be held at least one in each school term, and such special meetings may be held as the duties and business of the board may require. The members of the County Boards of Education shall receive no salary, but each member shall receive the sum of One Hundred Dollars annually for traveling and other expenses incident to attending the meetings and transacting the business of the board within the county; provided, however, that in Howard County each member of the Board of Education shall receive annually the sum of Two Hundred Dollars for such traveling and other expenses [.] and in Allegany County each member of the Board of Education shall receive not more than Two Hundred Dollars annually for such traveling and other expenses.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an acute emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly of Maryland, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

SEC. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JUNE 1, 1951.
