(b) All such scholarships for Baltimore County AND FOR THE THIRD LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF BALTIMORE CITY shall be awarded after a competitive examination supervised and graded as provided hereinabove in this section, and shall be awarded by the Dean of Admissions or Committee on Admissions THE COMMITTEE ON ADMISSIONS, OR THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES of the college or institution concerned, taking into consideration the financial condition of the parents or guardians of the several applicants, also as provided hereinabove in this section.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 608

(Senate Bill 315)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 4A(a) of Article 89B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "State Roads," relating to the acquisition of property by the State Roads Commission and the method that may be used to acquire such property, including the condemnation thereof.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 4A(a) of Article 89B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "State Roads," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

4A.

(a) The State Roads Commission may acquire by gift, purchase, condemnation or otherwise, real property or any interest in such property for highway construction
