CHAPTER 624

(Senate Bill 432)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," sub-title "Restrictions Upon Licensees," said new section to be known as Section 112A and to follow immediately after Section 112 of said Article, relating to the employment of minors in connection with the sale of alcoholic beverages or permitting certain minors to loiter about premises where alcoholic beverages are sold.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," sub-title "Restrictions Upon Licensees," said new section to be known as Section 112A, to follow immediately after Section 112 of said Article, and to read as follows:

112A. (a) Worcester County. In Worcester County it shall be unlawful for any licensee under this Article to employ any person under the age of twenty-one years in the sale of alcoholic beverages, unless permit so to do is obtained from the Sheriff and State's Attorney of Worcester County.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any licensee under this Article to allow any minor or minors under the age of twenty-one years to loaf or loiter about the place of business for which such license is issued; restaurants may, however, serve meals without alcoholic beverages to minors.

(c) Any person or persons, upon indictment and conviction of violation of any of the provisions of this section, shall be fined a sum not in excess of Two Hundred Dollars
