CHAPTER 638

(House Bill 363)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 328 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses," sub-title "Dog Licenses in the Counties," clarifying the provisions of said section.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 328 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Licenses," sub-title "Dog Licenses in the Counties," be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

328. Any person may kill any dog which he sees in the act of pursuing, worrying, attacking, wounding or killing any poultry or livestock, or attacking human beings whether or not such dog bears the proper license tag required by these provisions. There shall be no liability on such persons in damages
