Whereas, Mr. Walter Dziwulski was appointed a member of the Police Department of Baltimore City as of February 11, 1943, and served in the Department for approximately six years until March 24, 1949; and

Whereas, as of the latter date, Mr. Dziwulski resigned from the Department in order to go into business of his own; and

Whereas, Mr. Dziwulski is no longer in private business and desires to be re-instated into the Police Department of Baltimore City; and

Whereas, Mr. Dziwulski left the Police Department of his own accord and in good standing and would make a valuable addition to the Baltimore Police Force; now, therefore

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Genearl Assembly of Maryland, That the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to re instate Mr. Walter Dziwulski is a member of the Police Department of Baltimore City according to the rank and standing held by him immediately prior to his resignation from this department in March, 1949.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO THE CHARTER AND PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF BALTIMORE CITY (1949 EDITION, BEING ARTICLE 4 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND), TITLE "BALTIMORE CITY," SAID NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 532A, TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 532 THEREOF, TO BE UNDER THE SUBTITLE "POLICE COMMISSIONER," AND UNDER THE SUBHEADING "ORGANIZATION OF FORCE," AUTHORIZING AND EMPOWERING THE POLICE COMMISSIONER OF BALTIMORE CITY TO REINSTATE ANY FORMER MEMBER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF BALTIMORE CITY WHO LEFT HIS EMPLOYMENT AS SUCH FOR OTHER THAN DISCIPLINARY REASONS REGARDLESS OF THE TIME OF LEAVING.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL AS-SEMBLY OF MARYLAND, THAT A NEW SECTION BE AND IT IS HEREBY ADDED TO THE CHARTER AND PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF BALTIMORE CITY (1949 EDI-
