TION, BEING ARTICLE 4 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND), TITLE "BALTIMORE CITY," SAID NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 532A, TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 532 THEREOF, TO BE UNDER THE SUB-TITLE "POLICE COMMISSIONER," AND UNDER THE SUB-HEADING "ORGANIZATION OF FORCE," AND TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

532A. THE SAID POLICE COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED IN HIS DISCRETION TO REINSTATE AS A MEMBER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF BALTIMORE CITY ANY PERSON WHO FORMERLY WAS A MEMBER OF SAID DEPARTMENT AND WHO LEFT SUCH EMPLOYMENT FOR OTHER THAN DISCIPLINARY REASONS. THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY AND BE EFFECTIVE REGARDLESS OF THE TIME AT WHICH SAID FORMER MEMBER LEFT HIS EMPLOYMENT AS A MEMBER OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF BALTIMORE CITY.

SEC. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JUNE 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 643

(House Bill 516)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 120 of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County," sub-title "Indian Head," providing that the Town Commissioners of Indian Head shall be elected for two year terms and shall be paid compensation for their service as such and removing an obsolete provision from said section.
