(c) It shall be unlawful at any time for any person to haul a seine for the catching or taking of fish north or east or in shore from a straight line drawn between Benoni's Point and Chlora's Point.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 653

(House Bill 628)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 181, 182, 183, 184, 185 and 187 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments", sub-title "State Civil Defense", as said sections were enacted by Chapter 563 of the Acts of 1949, making the State Civil Defense Agency a separate and independent agency of the State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 181, 182, 183, 184, 185 and 187 of Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Governor—Executive and Administrative Departments", sub-title "State Civil Defense", as said sections were enacted by Chapter 563 of the Acts of 1949, be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

181. (State Civil Defense Agency.) (a) The Governor is hereby authorized and directed to create a Civil Defense Agency [under the Adjutant General and upon the recommendation of the Adjutant General] *and* to appoint a Director of Civil Defense who shall be the administrator thereof. The Director
